

## Bonner County Sportsmen's Foundation Scholarship

Awarded in honor of Leo Hadley and other outstanding sportsmen and women.

### 2021 Scholarship Official Rules

Three \$500 scholarships will be awarded to Bonner County residents planning to advance their education, and who are interested in outdoor and conservation activities, have completed a Hunter Education program, and may have personal or family participation in local sportsman and civic organizations. Other rules are listed. Please read them carefully and be sure to include a copy of your Hunter Education card or certificate, or a recent hunting license, when submitting your scholarship application.

1. The scholarship will be awarded to a Bonner County resident to defray the cost of tuition, books, or room and board at an institute of higher learning approved by the BCSF.
2. Disbursement of the money will be made upon presentation of the recipient's college, university, trade school, or similar program's invoice as proof of enrollment, to the Bonner County Sportsmen's Foundation (BCSF).
3. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the school of higher learning.
4. Application must be completed and postmarked by no later than April 15, 2021. If asked, the applicant must be willing to appear for a personal interview.
5. Application for the scholarship constitutes permission to use applicant's name and or likeness for purpose of promotion of the scholarship.
6. Application must be handwritten if possible, rather than computer generated, and filled out in its entirety.
7. If an item is not applicable, please put N/A in the blank, or attach a sheet with a further explanation.
8. Applicants will be evaluated on a comparative basis at the sole discretion of the BCSF Scholarship Committee.
9. Decisions will be final.
10. Application materials and decisions of the committee shall be confidential.
11. The scholarship recipient(s) will be chosen by June 1, 2021.
12. A copy of your Hunter Education card or certificate, or a copy of your recent hunting license must be included with this application.

Note: Bonner County Sportsmen's Foundation Scholarship applicants are welcome to include the Common Scholarship Application used by Public Schools in Bonner County, but scholarship applicants must also complete the specific form for the BCSF Scholarship, which is attached.
